Perform unit conversion (such as cm into m, kg into g) and compare the measurement by arranging them in ascending and descending order.

**Q-2.** Prepare a list of daily use items purchased by your parents for 10 days, make a neat list of the items along with their quantity and cost and calculate the total expenditure for each day as well as the overall expenditure for all 10 days.

**Q-3** Observe the various patterns present in nature in your surrounding such as leave veins ,flower petals, butterfly wings, spider webs, tree barks, floor tiles, fabric or other objects. Identify and draw at least 5 different pattern.

**Q-4.** Write the contact numbers of your family members in Roman Numerals by following International system of numbers and using commas correctly wherever required.

## **EVS**

**(Any Four)**

1. Make the ' Best Out of Waste ' turning common household trash into functional or decorative items, adhering to the 3Rs: Reduce, Reuse and Recycle.
2. Prepare a scrapbook with pictures of digestive system, respiratory system, circulatory system and excretory system. Below the pictures, mention briefly the main functions and importance of these systems.
3. Choose a bone (femur) or a muscle (biceps) and write a diary entry from its perspective in first - person narrative. The narrative must describe its job, it's interactions with other body parts and it's response during activities like running, eating and sleeping.
4. Make a bone with clay and show bone marrow, red blood cells, white blood cells and platelets.
5. On a white sheet of paper, draw the main bones of the body such as the skull, rib cage, spine, arms and legs. Carefully cut out each bone shape and paste them on a piece of cardboard to form a complete skeleton. Ask an elder for help while cutting and pasting. Label each bone with its name and add one fun or interesting fact about it.
